<p>You ride a bicycle?</p>	<p>Be open-minded and respectful of people using a motorized mobility aid (power chairs and mobility scooters).</p>
<p>You notice the presence of children with disabilities in your neighbourhood?</p>	<p>Inform your municipality of the need for adapted playground modules so all children can have access to them.</p>
